



To our Birth Center patients:

For the health and safety of our Birth Center patients, Island Hospital will have a separate entrance for expecting parents to use to access the Birth Center during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The temporary entrance will lead directly into the Birth Center allowing Birth Center patients to bypass the main hospital and, therefore, minimize their exposure to others. The entrance is located in the courtyard just east of the main entrance (look for a canopy and signs). Please also reference the map below.

Birth Center patients are asked to call (360) 299-1331 once they arrive on campus to notify the Birth Center staff that they are here. Staff will meet them at the door. At this time, only one (1) support person is allowed for laboring moms (no one under the age of 12).
